Through EULIS you will have access to Core Information for each participating country

Basic description of legal concepts

Contact information to authorities involved in the real property transactions.



Access to real property data is provided with use property-id (cadastral unit) or address of the property. Headers in the register output is presented in English. The Land Information is presented in the national language

EULIS background

- Initiative of Land Agencies in Austria, England & Wales, Finland, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Norway, Scotland and Sweden
- Started with support from EU (eContent) January 2002 - June 2004
- No intention to harmonise or standardise, but maybe converge
- Now being turned into an operational service

EULIS vision

- customers will have ready access to information about individual properties throughout Europe
- they will also have ready access to all necessary reference information on the land and property registration services provided, and the associated legal environment, in each European country
- all European land and property registration services will be readily accessible through a single portal

EULIS status report

- First partners in service this December
- Most of original partners into the service during spring 2006
- Others working on becoming part of the service, almost finished
- Others just starting and in discussions with others
- Negotiating eTen project – 4 more jurisdictions
- New logo and design
