

Kick off meeting of the project “European requirements toward to cadastral surveyors activities”

13-14 December 2006, Paris

1 Background

Based on outcomes of the EuroGeographics workshop “The role of land surveyors in the maintenance of Cadastre”, which was organised in Vilnius (Lithuania) at 23-24 March 2006 the attendees agreed on a need for further collaboration between major international bodies (CLGE, FIG, GE, WPLA) for getting a better understanding on a state of the art in European countries regarding to land surveyors activities, sharing ‘best practice’ and, considering EU internal market leads toward liberalization and globalization, starting a dialogue on guidance for common “European requirements” for land surveyors as far as it is relevant for maintenance of real estate cadastre.

- Agree on the PPP project’s expected deliverables
- Review and detail the workplan
- Discuss and share common principles and requirements for land surveyors
