Developing the Implementation Plan (WP11)

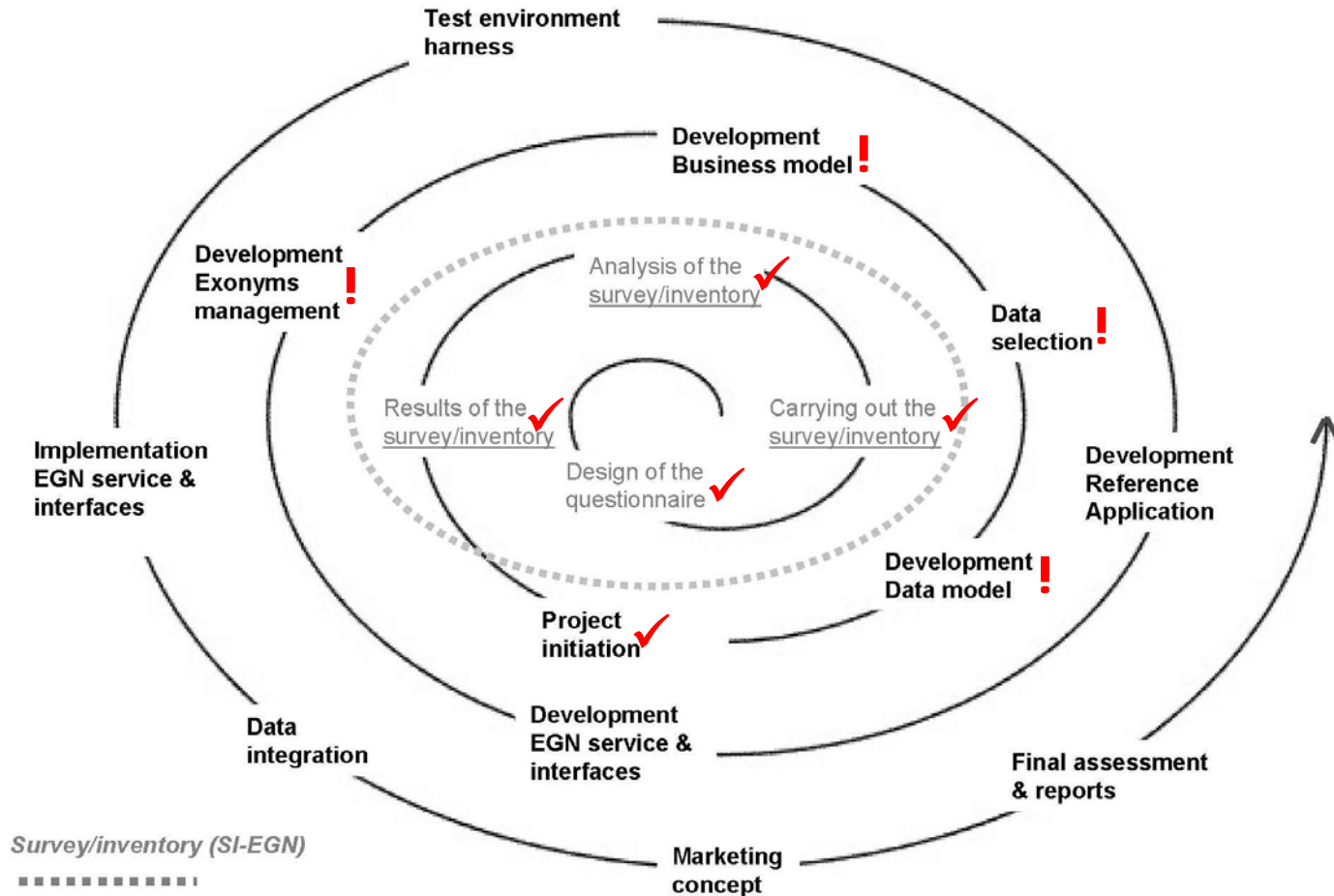
During the project lifetime:

- *“At least 5 to 10 countries of the Reference Group will be connected”* (according to the grant agreement with the EC)

Implementation Plan for the years beyond the project end:

- Opening the door for full European coverage
- Provision of specifications & technology free of charge
- Sustainability of actions after EC funding by EuroGeographics and BKG
- Further funding possibilities will be discussed with EC

Spiral engineering process for 2006 - 2008

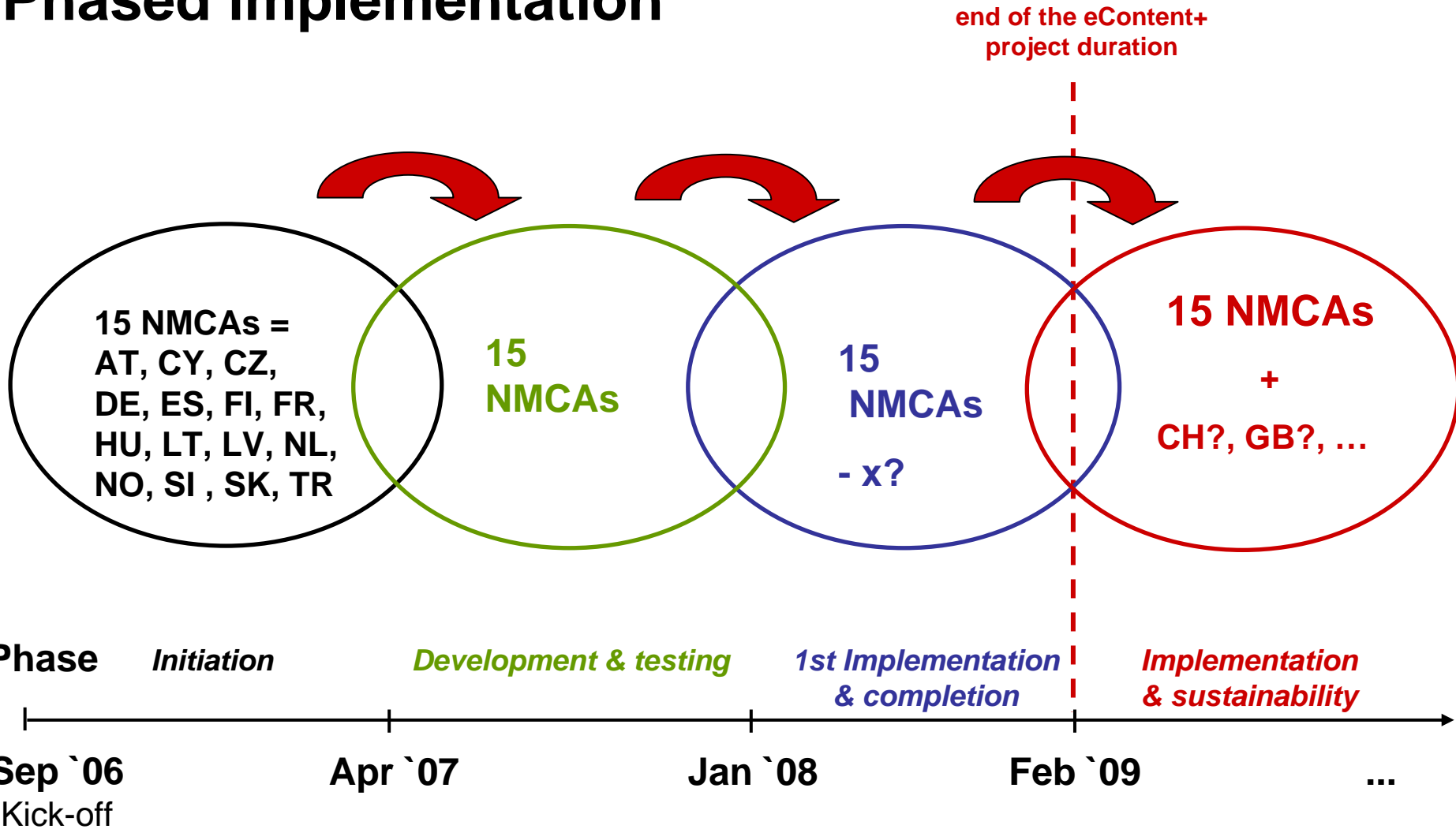


Phased implementation

Objectives:

- To **connect 15 countries/NMCAs** to the EGN infrastructure within the eContentplus-funded project duration.
- To **subsequently phase in the NMCAs** for the **development & testing phase** of the EGN infrastructure & services across the project duration.

Next steps:

- Organization of an **IT-Meeting on Security issues**,
in April / May 2007.
- EGN Consortium will send NMCAs a ~~Reply Back Letter~~ -> **MoU**,
NMCAs provide confirmation **after IT-Meeting**
- Participation in the workshop on **Implementing Pan-European
EGN Web services** in November 2007.
- 'Analysis of the state of the art: issues for implementing EGN'
- Creating a **User Testing Component**
(for the testing phase) very likely **until December 2007.**
