Summary

One objective of WP12 'Awareness & Dissemination' was to prepare a multimedia PowerPoint presentation of the project that can be automatically run. The presentation should be for the general public describing consortium, project objectives, challenges and benefits. The first version of the project presentation should be delivered three months after the beginning of the project (D12.1) and the final version at the end of the project (D12.6).

Deliverable D12.6 as the end version of the multimedia project presentation shows the complete outcome of the project. It demonstrates the complexity of geographical names, its importance in everyday life and illustrates the linkage between endonyms and exonyms. Furthermore the two windows of the EGN Central Service, i.e. the EGN Reference Application and the EGN ArcGIS Extension are shown. The linkage to INSPIRE as well as to EuroGeographics and its products is demonstrated.

The Multimedia Project Presentation has been created by Proctors & Stevensen, a British company, specialised in making video presentations and will be shown at the End-review meeting in Luxembourg at April 8, 2009. Afterwards a short version will be accessible via the EGN website whereas the full video presentation will be submitted to the EC as DVD.
